


The Museum of Everyday Objects Large Scale Papier Mâché Sculpture



In this capstone 3D Art lesson, student artists collaborate to create large scale paper mache sculptures inspired by Pop Artists Claus Oldenburg and Coosje van Bruggen. Techniques taught include building strong and sturdy cardboard armatures using recycled materials, then adding paper mache for strength. Finally, objects are brought to life with colorful paper decoupage and printed or hand drawn logos. Student self evaluate on their collaborative process, paper mache techniques, and the scale and sturdiness of their finished sculpture. Finally, students find an appropriate location in the school to display their finished artwork as a legacy project.
